

# INTERNATIONAL STUDENT ENTRANCE REQUIREMENTS

Brandon Flight Centre is happy to welcome students from across the globe. However there are some special entrance requirements to make sure that you are set up for success. Because of the unique challenges associated with international education, Brandon Flight Centre requires all international students to be at least 18 years of age at time of commencement.

## Educational Requirements:

- Grade 12 high school diploma or equivalent
  - must have grade 12 advanced math (Calculus and Trigonometry)
  - must have grade 12 English (or other language grammar course and English proficiency)
  - Grade 12 physics is strongly recommended but not required
- All students must submit a full high school (Grade equivalent of 9-12) transcript.
- Students with post secondary education are encouraged to send their post secondary transcripts in addition to their high school transcripts

## Medical Requirements:

Students must be able to continuously demonstrate they are fit to undergo the rigors of flight training by submitting an aviation medical with your application to Brandon Flight Centre. This is different from the immigration medical and the two cannot be used interchangeably.

It is preferable to complete a Canadian Aviation Medical if an approved doctor is available in your area. You can find the list of all international Canadian Aviation Medical Examiners (CAMEs) here:

In the event that a Canadian medical cannot be completed while overseas, a commercial level aviation medical from your home country may be used for admission purposes only. Upon arrival in Canada you will need to complete the Canadian medical before you will be authorized to fly solo, typically within your first month of training.

If you do not have a Canadian medical, plan on arriving in Canada at least 6 weeks in advance to have that processed and returned to you prior to solo. Aviation medicals are processed by Transport Canada directly and Brandon Flight Centre has no control over the speed of their processing or their overall administration.
